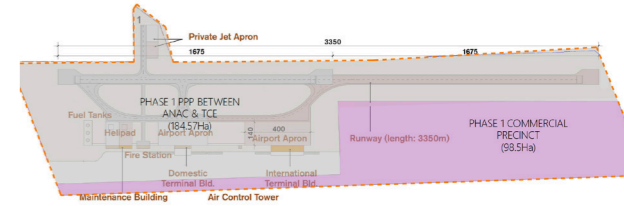
1 Aman Bulk Power & Water

- Final round of commissioning on all bulk utilities
- System final connections and live activation
- Filtration system final testing
- Secured pump station at Massingir Dam
- Supply source for conservation and operations
- Handover to Aman development team on November 3rd.



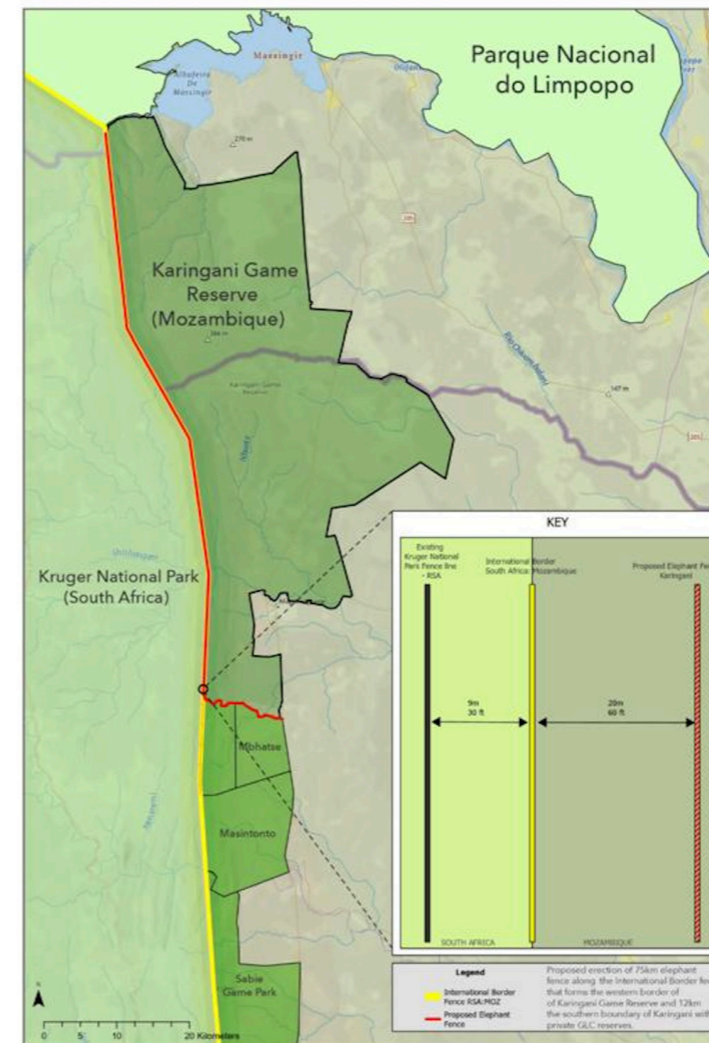
3 Massingir Airport

- Shareholder agreement signed
- Construction contracts under negotiation
- Commencing perimeter fence rehabilitation in November
- 30 new local jobs
- Soil and stress tests finalised in airstrip surfacing study
- Commence build of airport in Q1 2026
- 9 month project timeline



2 Aman Tourism Roads

- 60+ km of Aman hotel roads under construction
- 25 new local jobs created for construction of roads, culverts, bridges
- Road surveys and final ecological inspections underway
- Road staking commenced
- Aman Phase 1a roads for construction access to start on Nov 4th
- Aman Phase 1b hotel tourism roads to start on Jan 1st.



4 Human-Wildlife Conflict Protection Fence

- Designed state-of-the-art human-wildlife conflict fence on SA-MZ border
- Partnership with ANAC
- Fence approved by ANAC. Awaiting clearance by the Ministry of Foreign and Ministry of Home Affairs.
- Access road & construction site establishment underway
- Fence material procurement underway
- 1 year build
- 28 new local jobs created



5 New Staff Accommodation & Infrastructure

- Major investment in the past 18 months with additional capital spends from Q1 2026 to cater to new local hires
- Full operational & occupied medical health post, canteens, kitchens, laundry, gyms and IT/Antipoaching communications infrastructure
- Over 100 local community jobs created in construction
- To run facilities, we currently employ 422 people from the provinces of Maputo & Gaza
- Ongoing job recruitment through 2026 in all departments with 20 new hires in Q1
- 270kW of solar power across to PV plants full commissioned
- Advanced water supply and treatment activated
- Ongoing regeneration of native landscape & plant species



7 Education & Training

- Investment into 3-year student participation program at South African College of Tourism (SACT)
- Completed selection of 20 youth female candidates from Mapulanguene and Massingir for the 2026 SACT cohort
- Ongoing education and training initiatives at Karingani for local community hires in waste management, construction, wildlife conservation, tracking and antipoaching.
- Ongoing training in international culinary skills for staff at Mbilu and Xinghana Lodge
- Celebration of Women's Day to show the importance of women's contribution in the labour sector



6 Community Projects

- Ongoing implementation of a water supply system in Cubo with solar and a 3.5 km pipeline to storage tanks in the community
- Handover of a 500 tons per hour Mill for supporting local agricultural production in Mapulanguene
- Supported the Maguiguane Khossa Day Festival
- Management support to activities of Cubo Game Park, Lda and Xinghana Lodge including holding the General Assembly.
- Sponsorship of the Massingir District Sports Championship



8 Conservation & Wildlife

- Captured and relocated 2 leopards to Gorongosa National Park with MWA
- Captured and relocated 6 Spotted hyena to Coutada 11
- Introduced almost 400 Zebra and 300 Blue Wildebeast as part of game augmentation program
- Collaborated with ANAC to resolve more than 25 Human Wildlife Conflict cases in our communities
- Completed 8th Annual Game Census and first wet season elephant census
- Dehorned and satellite tagged numerous white rhino
- Hosted the Greater Lebombo Transfrontier Conservation Area Rhino protection conference
